**4TH GENERATION TERM CONTRACT FOR MANAGEMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF
THE SCOTTISH TRUNK ROAD NETWORK – NORTH WEST UNIT
A85 ST FILLANS BUS STOP IMPROVEMENTS**

BEAR Scotland, acting on behalf of Transport Scotland, are planning to carry out the construction of new hardstanding areas throughout St Fillans. The works will create new crossing points and safe areas for bus passengers to wait. The new hard standing areas will be constructed using bus boarding kerbs to aid access and egress for passengers. A location plan is enclosed for geographic clarity.

The works are programmed for construction from Monday 4th December to Friday 15th December 2017, between 7am and 7pm.

The road will remain open at all times, however to ensure the safety of the workforce and members of the travelling public, it will be necessary for a two way temporary traffic light system to be implemented. Outwith working hours the traffic management, including temporary lights, may need to be in place. There will be no weekend working.

Work is being carried out in conjunction with Perth and Kinross Council, who will be installing new flag posts at these bus stops and erecting two new bus shelters to replace the life expired wooden shelters.

BEAR Scotland and Transport Scotland, along with Perth and Kinross Council, wish to thank the local community for their patience whilst this essential work is carried out.
