St Fillans Community Council Treasurer's Report - Oct 2021

For the Year Ended: 31st August 2021

The accounts have been prepared and audited. At the end of the previous financial year (31st August 2020) the Treasurer's bank account held a balance of £322.52.

Since then, our **income** for the current year was £669.32 made up of

- 1. Advertising revenue from the Community Council Website of £200
- 2. A P&K Council Insurance Subsidy of £91.84
- 3. A P&K Council Administrative Grant of £377.48

Expenditure over the financial year was £788.12 made up of

- 1. Community Council Insurance of £127.89
- 2. IT annual maintenance and domain registration of the village website of £507.60
- 3. Rent of the playing field and play park of £104.00
- 4. Signage for neighbourhood watch and dog fouling of £48.63

Our surplus at the end of the year was -£118.80.

At the end of the current financial year the Treasurer's bank account held a balance of £203.72 being £322.52 (carried forward from last year) -£118.80 (this year's surplus).

It is therefore anticipated that we will get a "top up grant" from P&K to cover administration costs as the bank balance is below £700 in the amount of £496.28.

The following items falling into this tax year will be allocated to next years accounts:

1. Hire of the Sandison Hall of £80

Finally, a big thank you to Johnston Brown for auditing the accounts.
