The Village acre lands appears to have been allocated by number in accordance with the property Feu number. By the 1880s the acres had been taken over by Littleport

The tenants listed were taken from the 1861 census and the house names from the 2021 St Fillans Phone Book.

In 1876 John Carmichael sold plot No 24 to Dr. George Murray Porteous who then applied to Drummond Estate for a Feu Charter this was refused and he took it to the Court of Session and won his case Porteous v Willoughby & Carmichael 23rd July 1878. This was a landmark case allowing all future Owner's a right to a Feu charter

Villas started to appear starting with Port Mohr in 1861 - Victoria Cottage (Achray) - Lochearn & Holly 1872 - Lake Cottage 1873 - Earnbank (Beaconsfield /Wellendura) 1874 - Ancaster & Earnholm 1876 - School (Station Rd) Neish Earnbank & Dunollan 1877 - Dunfillan Cottage (Glenalbyn) 1878-9 Dundurn Parish Church - 1881 - Tigh-na-Craig, The Oaks & Village Shop 1884 Colleonard 1885 - Rath Erenn 1891 - Craigdarroch 1895 - Fox's Knowe 1896 - Rosehill 1898 - The Birran
